### **Committee Updates:**

- \* Could the secretary's booth be moved to the side of the ring? Vickie will check with Chris Lyons
- \* Warm-up ring needs to be mowed; main ring needs to be dragged; barn needs to be unlocked so we can get the dressage ring materials and jumps out for set up and stalls can be available for the show day
